### Minutes of Regular Meeting

May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020

**Reports from the Governing Body:** The Council discussed parking on Third Street. Currently, there is no parking allowed on the east side of the street. A speeding problem on Third Street was also brought up and will be passed on to the Greenwood Sheriff's Department. Another subject mentioned on Third Street was installing a culvert at the north end of the alley. It was decided not to install it because it would cause too much traffic.

Covid-19 updates and re-opening decisions were discussed. It was decided to continue City meetings via Zoom until June 1<sup>st</sup>, the City pool can open on Memorial Day or after, camping at the lake will be allowed on May 18<sup>th</sup> with bathrooms remaining closed and City Park will be opened immediately with bathrooms closed for the time being. Samantha made the first motion. Jody seconded. Motion carried 4-0. The issue was revisited later in the meeting and it was decided to also leave the City Park equipment closed until May 18<sup>th</sup>. Nick made the first motion. Samantha seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

It was reported that a sewer line on McKinley will need to be replaced. The community garden, a pothole by the school, and the ballparks were also discussed.
