### **Minutes of Regular Meeting**

**November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020**

The paint machine costs \$193.30, the cones cost \$27.85 each, and the watchtowers cost \$31.07 each. James also discussed the sewer plant, the water line coming into town, Grant Street, the dump truck, and possibly installing helpful tools in the street for a blind citizen who lives near the street.

**Clerk and Treasurer Reports:** There were no reports.

**Reports from the Governing Body:** The Council reviewed several quotes to have a tree cut down and removed from the City Park. The Council voted unanimously to approve Justin Sage's quote of \$700.00. They would also like him to look at other trees that need cut down or limbs removed. Daryl made the first motion.
